Making the welfare of young people a priority. Protecting children at risk could override the rights and needs of those adults working with them.

Following the N&URC Code of Conduct guidance

Enabling everyone, whatever their age, culture, disability, gender, language, racial origin, religious belief and/or sexual identity to participate in rowing in a fun and safe environment.

Taking all reasonable steps to protect young people from harm, discrimination and degrading treatment. Respecting their rights, wishes and feelings.

Taking seriously all suspicions and allegations of poor practice or abuse and responding swiftly and appropriately to them in accordance with British Rowing procedures.

Ensuring that all club members and volunteers who work with our young people are suitable for that responsibility and are provided with relevant training.
